## **APPLYING FOR A VISA AT HULL**

### **INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A TRANSIT VISA FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN A SPORTS ACTIVITY**

**PLEASE NOTE THAT VISAS MUST BE APPLIED FOR IN PERSON ONLY (NOT BY POST)**

The Transit Visa (TS) category 'S' is available for persons who are travelling to Thailand for the purpose of engaging in a sport and for persons who are part of the official support team of the sports person.

It will be necessary for the applicant to provide a document/letter from the relevant Thai Authority and other organisations as appropriate providing the following information:-

1. Evidence that the named person(s) who is (are) either the sports person or who is (are) part of the support team of the sports person who will be officially involved in participating in a particular sports event taking place in Thailand.  
The letter will need to include the following:
  - a) Name of sports event.
  - b) Date(s) of sports event.
  - c) Venue of sports event.
  - d) Duration of sports event.
  - e) Name of sports person or member of support team.
  
2. Evidence that the applicant will be exiting Thailand to another country within 30 days of entry such as copy of onward flight ticket or similar.

### ***ONLY A SINGLE ENTRY VISA WILL BE GRANTED***

The **single entry** visa is valid for three months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of up to 30 days. Do not stay in Thailand beyond the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date as stamped in the applicant's passport.

When you visit the Royal Thai Consulate at Hull to apply for this visa you will need to bring with you the following:-

1. Your passport (minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
2. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
3. Completed Visa Application Form.
4. Visa fee of £20 plus £10 processing charge, £30 in cash only.
5. The evidence documents listed above "1. a to e).
