APPLYING FOR A VISA AT HULL

TOURIST Multiple (TR)

INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A TOURIST VISA "TR" WITH MULTIPLE ENTRIES

**PLEASE NOTE THAT VISAS MUST BE APPLIED FOR IN PERSON ONLY (NOT BY POST)
THIS VISA IS ISSUED AT HULL USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR**

Tourist Visa with **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** is valid for 6 months from date of issue and allows an unlimited number of entries each allowing a stay of up to 60 days. If exiting Thailand before the 60th day all remaining days of that entry are lost. It may be possible to extend each 60-day stay by a further 30 days by visiting a local Thai Immigration Office. The fee for each extension is THB1900.

The validity of this visa commences from the date it is issued and expires 6 months later. The expiry date of the visa is shown as the **ENTER BEFORE** date. For example, if the visa was issued on **01 JAN 2017 (DATE OF ISSUE)** the **ENTER BEFORE** date would be **30 JUN 2017**. This means that your **final** 60-day entry into Thailand must be no later than **29 June 2017**. Each time you enter Thailand you receive a rectangular stamp in your passport stating date of entry and the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date which will be 60 days after entry. Do **not** remain in Thailand beyond the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date. Each time you exit Thailand you will receive a triangular stamp in your passport stating date of exiting Thailand. With careful planning it is possible to get an accumulation of almost 8 months in Thailand with this visa by making your final entry into Thailand 3-4 days **before** the **ENTER BEFORE** date as shown on the visa.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE, HULL

It is necessary for the applicant or someone nominated by the applicant to visit the Royal Thai Consulate **IN PERSON**. Our address is Royal Thai Consulate, Priory Court, Saxon Way, Hessle, East Yorkshire HU13 9PB.

To apply for the Tourist Visa with **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** each applicant needs to provide the following:-

1. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport type photos attached.
The form is available for completion when you visit us.
2. Passport with minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
For holders of a UK passport it must state that they are a BRITISH CITIZEN.
Holders of UK passport which states they are a BRITISH OVERSEAS CITIZEN must obtain a visa for all visits to Thailand even if only for one day.
Holders of all other passport must provide evidence that they are entitled to be in the UK (visa or residence card) and also provide evidence of where they live in the UK (utility bill, bank account statement, UK Driving Licence or UK residence permit showing their name and address in the UK).

3. Copies of your latest 6 month's bank statements showing a minimum of £5,000 (or equivalent in certain other currencies) at the beginning/end of each month. Bank statements must show applicant's name and address. Children up to 20 years of age are not required to meet these financial requirements provided they are travelling with a parent (copy of child's birth certificate required).

If using business bank account statements they must:

- a) also show the name of the applicant.

and

- b) be supported by a copy of the company's Register of Shareholders.

Married couples are required to meet these requirement **each**.

4. For children up to the age of 20 accompanying one or both parents it is necessary to provide a copy of each child's birth certificate.
5. If you are employed, a letter from employer confirming that you are or have been employed by them, ie from date commenced employment to date of letter. The letter must not say that you are no longer employed by them.
or
If you are self-employed, copy of your HMRC SA100 or SA105 Self Assessment Tax Form for the last tax year.
or
If you are retired (at any age) and receiving a State or Private Pension, confirmation of receiving such pension by providing a copy of your Pension Statement or similar which must bear your name and address.
6. Copy of Confirmed Return/Onward Air Ticket to and from Thailand (return to be within the validity and terms of the visa).
7. Copy of Reservation Confirmation from the first hotel or similar where you will be staying in Thailand.
or
If you are staying in Thailand with relatives or friends, copy of an electricity utility bill showing their name and address in Thailand (in Thai language).
or
If you rent a property in Thailand, a copy of the rental agreement showing your name and address in Thailand.
8. Visa fee £125 plus £10 processing charge = **£135 IN CASH ONLY**.

Applicants who cannot provide ALL the above will be granted only a SINGLE ENTRY Tourist Visa.

We offer a service whereby you can email all documentation in advance for us to check prior to you visiting us. We check everything and let you know if we require any further documents. When everything meets the requirements you will be invited to visit us so we can issue the visa. If you wish to utilise this service please email everything to enquiries@thaiconsul-uk.com.

Passport holders of the following countries must apply for their visa in person only at the Royal Thai Embassy, London:

Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Cameroon, Central African Republic, China, Congo (Democratic Republic), Congo (Republic), Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Ghana, Guinea, India, Iran, Iraq, Kosovo, Lebanon, Liberia, Libya, Nepal, Nigeria, North Korea, Pakistan, Palestine, Sao Tome & Principe, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Yemen.
