APPLYING FOR A VISA AT HULL

TOURIST Single (TR)

INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A TOURIST VISA “TR” WITH SINGLE ENTRY

**PLEASE NOTE THAT VISAS MUST BE APPLIED FOR IN PERSON ONLY (NOT BY POST)
THIS VISA IS ISSUED AT HULL USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR**

Tourist Visa with **SINGLE** entry is valid for 3 months from date of issue and allows a single stay of up to 60 days. If exiting Thailand before the 60th day all remaining days of that entry are lost. It may be possible to extend the 60-day stay by a further 30 days by visiting a local Thai Immigration Office. The fee for the extension is THB1900.

The validity of this visa is 3 calendar months from date of issue. The expiry date of the visa shows on the visa as the **ENTER BEFORE** date. For example, if the visa was issued on **01 JAN 2016 (DATE OF ISSUE)** the **ENTER BEFORE** date would be **31 MAR 2016**. This means that entry into Thailand must be no later than **30 Mar 2016**. On entering Thailand you will receive a rectangular stamp in your passport stating date of entry and the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date which will be 60 days after your date of entry. Do **not** remain in Thailand beyond the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date. If exiting Thailand before the 60th day all remaining days are lost. The visa ceases to be valid the day before the **ENTER BEFORE** date as shown on the visa and can no longer be used. When you exit Thailand you will receive a triangular stamp in your passport stating date of exiting Thailand.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE, HULL

It is necessary for the applicant or someone nominated by the applicant to visit the Royal Thai Consulate, Hull **IN PERSON**. Our address is Royal Thai Consulate, Priory Court, Saxon Way, Hessle, East Yorkshire HU13 9PB.

To apply for the Tourist Visa with **SINGLE ENTRY** each applicant needs to provide the following:-

1. Completed Visa Application Form - available for completion when you visit us.
2. Passport with minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
For holders of UK passport it must state that they are a BRITISH CITIZEN. Holders of UK passport which states they are a BRITISH OVERSEAS CITIZEN must obtain a visa for all visits to Thailand even if only for one day. Holders of all other passport must provide evidence that they are entitled to be in the UK (visa or residence card) and also provide evidence of where they live in the UK (utility bill, bank account statement or UK residence permit showing their name and address in the UK).
3. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
4. Visa fee of £25 + £10 processing charge – **total of £35 payable in CASH ONLY**.

At the end of the 60-day (+ 30-day extension) stay it will be necessary to exit Thailand. If exiting to a neighbouring country and re-entering Thailand by air without a visa you should be allowed a stay of 30 days, if re-entering overland you will be allowed a stay of only 15 days, however, this is entirely at the discretion of the Immigration Officer on duty at the time. If entering Thailand without a visa you will be allowed a maximum of 90 days within any 6-month rolling period. Also be aware the Royal Thai Embassies and Consulates in neighbouring countries may restrict the number of 60-day tourist visas they will grant.
